Summer School is a fantastic opportunity to meet new friends and to have fun after a long summer off school.

The main focus of Summer School is to develop your confidence just as you prepare to join us at Cardinal Hume Catholic School. You will work individually and with other students, building skills in team work having an opportunity to get to know the school and some staff ready for the start of the new year.

Activities include problem solving tasks such as the Egg Box Challenge, crafts, perhaps cooking and Transition activities that will help you to know your way round school.

You will also complete two courses:

Progress Course looks at personal development and building self-confidence. You will keep a journal over the week, and will look at issues such as self-image, self-confidence and making and maintaining friendships. For most of the course you will work in groups of all boys or all girls.

Gamestars develops your ingenuity in designing and developing team games/challenges and developing teamwork and leadership. It is not about competitive sport, but it is lots of fun
