## Application Procedures and Timetable

To apply for a place at this school, you must complete a common application form (CAF) available from Gateshead Council. All applications will be considered at the same time, and after the closing date for admissions applications, October 31<sup>st</sup>.

If there are more places than applicants then all applicants will be accepted.

If there are more applicants than places, the following criteria apply:

<b>A</b>	Looked after children and previously looked after children
<b>B</b>	Catholic children who attend a feeder primary school.
<b>C</b>	Catholic children who will have an older brother or sister at the school at the time of admission.
<b>D</b>	Catholic children who live within the catchment area
<b>E</b>	Other children who have an older brother or sister at the school at the time of admission.
<b>F</b>	Children of School Staff
<b>G</b>	Children of another Christian denomination who live within the catchment area who attend a feeder Catholic School.
<b>H</b>	Children of another Christian denomination who live within the catchment area who do not attend a feeder Catholic School.
<b>I</b>	Other Catholic children who do not live within the catchment area.
<b>J</b>	All other children from the feeder primary schools.
<b>K</b>	All other children

**NB The school has no power to refuse pupils placed during the year by the Local Authority via the Fair Access Protocols (pupil placement panel) . These children are admitted outside Cardinal Hume admission arrangements.**

## 1 Application Procedures and Timetable

To apply for a place at this school, parents must complete an application form available from the school.

All applications will be considered at the same time and after the closing date for admissions which is July 31<sup>st</sup> 2017 on the year of application.

## 2 Entry Requirements for Admission into Year 12

1. The minimum entry requirement for admission into year 12 is dependent on the course of study that a student wishes to study.
2. The minimum entry requirement for any level 3 course is GCSE English Language at 4 or above with 4 other GCSEs or equivalent at 4 or above.
3. For AS/A2 courses the general requirement is a high level 5 or above at GCSE in the subject chosen. In some Mathematics and Science courses students will be invited to complete an additional assessment to determine suitability for the course.
4. For vocational courses, a merit or higher in an appropriate level 2 vocational course is required.

If the sixth form is oversubscribed and all students have met the criteria above, they will be selected using the oversubscription criteria below.

Order of Priority	Oversubscription Criteria
A	Looked after and previously looked after students
B	Catholic students who attend Cardinal Hume Catholic school
C	Catholic students who live within the catchment area.
D	Other Catholic students
E	All other students who attend Cardinal Hume Catholic School.
F	Students of another Christian denomination
G	Students of other faiths
H	All other students
