



PARENTS TELEPHONE CONSULTATIONS Y7&8

Due to the current restrictions in school and the wider community, we are unable to offer Parents Consultation Evenings in their usual format. In order to safeguard the wellbeing of students, parents and staff, we are instead offering telephone appointments. These consultations are being carried out by tutors and other senior Pastoral staff, who will have access to your child's academic and pastoral records. Modular Reports, which inform you of their academic progress in each subject and summarise their attitude to learning, will be available to parents as usual on *My Child At School*.

What you should expect from the appointment:

The focus for the Consultation conversations will be Pastoral in nature, particularly how your child has settled back into school following Lockdown. The member of staff making the call will be able to answer your questions on changes to your child's day-to-day life in school, and you may have information you wish to share with the tutor which will help us to support your child at this challenging time.

When will appointments take place?

All appointments will take place over the last two weeks of this term. Consultation calls should take ten minutes, so times are offered in 15-minute slots.

What will happen during the appointment?

At the appointed time, you will receive a call from your child's tutor or other member of staff. Please be ready to accept the call as staff have many appointments and may not be able to call again after your time slot is over.
