

Year 10 and 11 (Key Stage 4)

RO32- Principles of care in health and social care settings (examined unit)

Within the two years of study, our students explore the rights of service users in health and social care settings, as well as person-centred values. They also learn effective communication in the sector and how to protect service users and service providers across health and social care settings. This is delivered through exam study across years 10 and 11.

RO33- Supporting Individuals through life events (coursework unit)

This unit educates our students on growth and development through the life stages. They learn how to understand the needs of individuals who have been affected by challenging life events and how sources of support should be adapted to meet their needs. This is assessed as coursework and will be submitted in the summer term of Year 10.

RO34- Creative and therapeutic activities (coursework unit)

In this unit students will research therapies and learn how they benefit different individuals. They explore the benefits of creative activities and plan their own activity to implement and deliver. Our students explore current health issues and the impact on society, as well as factors that influence health. This is assessed as coursework and will be submitted in the summer term of Year 11.
