

Demand for scholars' services fluctuates from year to year slightly, depending on the addresses of the new Y7 intake compared to the previous Y13. This year the 878 fills with students from Wardley / Pelaw – these are the students who receive priority passes, for whom there is no alternative service stopping on the north side of the Felling Bypass. Some students waiting at Meresyde have been unable to access the 878 service on occasion in the morning, and the 879 may be a preferable alternative.




