

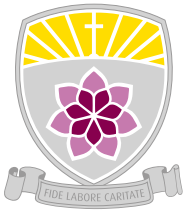

Students wear their school uniform with pride as ambassadors for Cardinal Hume Catholic School.



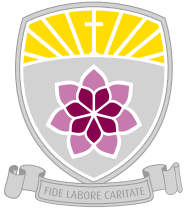


Uniform Policy September 2022

Students are expected to wear their school uniform with pride so that there is equality between all students and they can be ambassadors for Cardinal Hume Catholic School.

It is important that all students abide by the high standards set by the school and that they are seen as positive representatives of our school by the wider community. Our uniform policy is compliant with both Government and DfE guidance - there are a number of non-branded items that can be purchased from a range of outlets as well as second hand uniform options facilitated by *Michael Seghal & Sons*.

The appearance of all students must be deemed socially acceptable by the school. Failure to comply with any part of this policy may result in sanctions being imposed.

Black formal trousers – recommended trousers can be found online through our supplier. Other trousers may be worn but no leggings, jeans or tight fitting/stretchy styles, no decoration e.g. metal zips

White formal shirt – not polo shirt or fitted blouse

Plain black leather sensible shoes – no boots

Socks/tights – plain black opaque

White formal shirt – not polo shirt

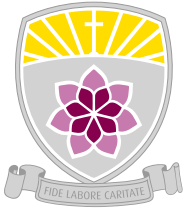

Additional uniform guidelines

- Outdoor coats must not be worn in the school building. Outdoor coats must be kept in lockers. No denim or leather coats may be worn to school.
- School hat – optional. Available from school. No other hat may be worn.
- Top buttons of shirts must be fastened to the neck and ties worn up to the collar. Shirts must be tucked into skirts or trousers.
- Black formal shoes – no boots, plimsolls or trainers.
- Belts, if worn, must be narrow and plain black.
- No visible tattoos.
- A wristwatch. Smartwatches are NOT allowed.
- No jewellery is allowed (Year 7-11). This includes clear jewellery in piercings.
- No make-up of any kind or fake tan.
- No fake nails or fake eyelashes.
- Hairstyles and colours must be deemed socially acceptable by the school.
- Long hair must be tied back in a ponytail or plaits at all times (Year 7-11).
- No extreme haircuts including lines or extreme differences in length.
No Skin fades with 'no blade / zero' and no hair should be shorter than a No 2.
No patterns should be visible in hair styles.
- No lines should be cut into eyebrows.
- **Sixth Form:** One pair of sleeper or stud earrings in ear lobes – girls.
Single sleeper or stud earring in 1 ear lobe – boys.
No other visible piercings. No other jewellery is allowed.
- **Sixth Form:** Natural make-up, neutral coloured nail varnish, no fake nails and no fake tan.
