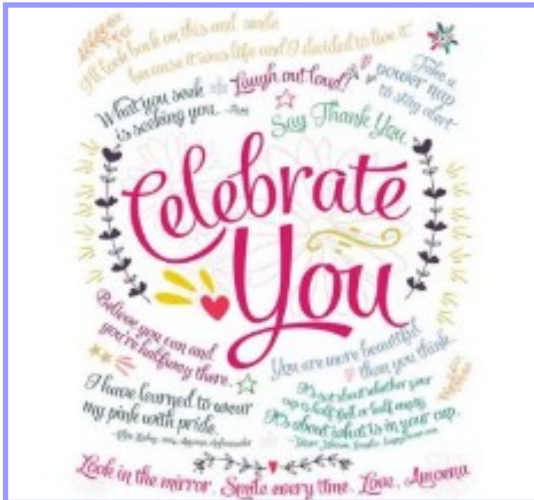




## BULLETIN FOR PARENTS AND PUPILS

Students who are keen to keep reading over the summer can see me to arrange an extended loan over the holidays.

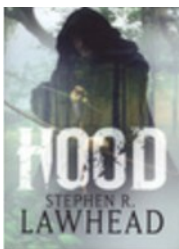
### Summer Reading Suggestions
